#1-AWARDS AT THE ISC 2026 BUBBLE BLOWOUT

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

9U-14U Divisions

- For all 9U-14U divisions we will recognize a "*PLAYER OF THE GAME*" and a "*PLAYER OF THE DIVISION AWARD.*"

PLAYER OF THE GAME-After the conclusion of each 9U-14U game, our field marshals will distribute a wrist band to one player from each team that they have nominated as the "Player of the Game." We honor kids with this award to recognize their hard work on the field, their contributions to their team, and their ability to play hard and still respect their opponent and the officials.

PLAYER OF THE DIVISION- We will also recognize the one player from each 9U-14U age group that we feel earned the recognition of

“Player of the Division.” The player that earns this award will be someone that has earned at least one wrist band by being selected as the “Player of the Game.”

Our tournament officials and coaching staff will work together to decide which player has demonstrated incredible effort in all games, played with both skill and tactical understanding, and has done so with respect to teammates, officials, and the rules of the game.

The “Player of the Division” award winner will be presented with a plaque at the conclusion of the group play games in your child’s age division and will have their picture taken. Therefore, please do not leave the tournament if your son or daughter received a wrist band from one of their games until you find out whether your child has won the “Player of the Division” award. We will post the winners of this award by the registration table by Field #2.

15U-17U Divisions

- We will also recognize a “Player of the Division Award” for all 15U-17U boys’ divisions, and for the 15U girls’ divisions at the ISC Bubble Blowout. This is an elite award handed out at the end of the tournament to the ONE player that our tournament officials and coaching staff have determined to be the most impactful player of the event in their age division.

The “Player of the Division Award” for the 15U-17U boys’ divisions and 15U girls’ division will be presented at the end of the group play games for the age division. We will post the award by the registration table. The winner of the award will be presented with a plaque and will have their picture taken by our tournament officials.

To clarify, we do not distribute individual wrist bands for the 15U-17U boys’ divisions and 15U girls’ divisions for the player of the game award.

Men’s Open and Women’s Open Division

- For over 23 years we have been recognizing the “All tournament team” for the Men’s Open and Women’s open divisions. Our coaching staff will select 6 players from each of these divisions to the ISC “BUBBLE

BLOWOUT ALL TOURNAMENT" team. This award will be presented at the same time we distribute the 1st and 2nd place trophies for those divisions.

TEAM AWARDS

9U-12U Divisions

All 9U-12U divisions are considered festival divisions. All 9U-12U teams are guaranteed 4 games, but there are no playoffs and therefore no team awards. We do not calculate age group winners at the 9U-12U ages.

13U and OLDER Divisions

In all 13U and older divisions, including men's open, women's open, Over 35, and the ISC Parent division, we will recognize a first place and second place team.

All members of the 1st place and 2nd place teams will receive an individual plaque and will be presented with the plaque by tournament officials at the end of the final game.

#2 -CONCESSIONS

We will offer some light concessions at the t-shirt merchandise table this year. Bottled water, sports drinks, fruit, and other snack options will be sold.

#3 -FOOD TRUCKS

#4- PARKING

I have attached the parking map. Please make sure that all your team members are sent the parking map.

There are two different categories on this map that are approved for parking.

- 1) The **MAIN PARKING AREAS** are highlighted in "blue" on the map.
- 2) There are also areas designated as **OVERFLOW PARKING** highlighted in the color "Orange" on the map.

The closest overflow parking is located just north of the HTRC in the Hawkeye Recreation Outdoor Sports Complex parking lot. This lot will be open all weekend. The walking time from this location will be 3-5 minutes at most.

Please make sure that you **DO NOT** park in the lot located just south of the HTRC. This new building is the facility for Hawkeye gymnastics and spirit squad. Parking is NOT permitted in this lot. Vehicles that are not authorized in this lot will be towed or ticketed.

Any vehicles that are parked in areas such as on the grass near the facility, on the gravel areas on Hawkeye Park Road, or in areas that are not marked and designated for parking, will be towed or ticketed.
